

## How to find us

### On foot or by bike

Located just north of the heart of the Dunfermline town centre, Pilmuir Street, A823 is just off Carnegie Drive from where we are signposted with brown tourist signs, complete with the intersecting road connected from the nearby high street and bus station. If you are cycling we have ample bike parking within our lockable outdoor safe area.

### By public transport

- Dunfermline Bus Station is a 5-minute walk away - <https://www.stagecoachbus.com/plan-a-journey>
- Dunfermline Train Station, on the Fife Circle rail line, is a 20 minute walk away through the town centre toward East Port and through the Public Park. A regular service operates via Kirkcaldy from the North and from Edinburgh in the South. ### Car or motorbike parking

- **Free car parking is available on Leys Park Road, only 5 minute walk away from the centre.**
